From the pastor's desk...

Dear Friends,

This week our scripture readings continue the bread of life discourse, a group of readings that talk about the need for us to be sustained by God alone. In our first reading we see God provide meat and bread for the Israelites traveling through the desert.

At first it seems almost shocking that a people whose prayers for so long had seemed to go unheeded by God and are finally answered, but as they begin to hunger they immediately complain. As they take their first breaths in freedom, a very human thing happens, they miss the comforts Egypt had provided. If we look at this in a spiritual sense, we see the things we are asked to leave behind in Christian discipleship, are often the comforts this world provides. Just like the Israelites this is a short-lived complaint as the real freedom we are offered proves much more satisfying, but only after growing pains. We are sustained by God only after we experience a death too self-reliance.

In our Gospel Christ teaches everyone around Him the idea that it is God, not Moses, who provided Bread from Heaven. It is God providing this same mana in the person of Christ. A bread that will finally satiate the need in our soul for belonging, for being cherished. This Bread from heaven can easily be seen by Catholics as a reference to the Eucharist, the only spiritual food that we will ever need. The source and summit of our relationship with God is the only food designed to feed our souls.

I think we can also look at this scripture passage in a wider sense, a relationship with Christ is the only thing that makes this world make sense. It is the primary relationship that takes us out of ourselves and makes self-sacrificing love the model by which we shape our lives.



Assumption Rosary Novena**






**Church Hours & Confessions**


